Currently, he serves as Program Director of the Advanced GI-MIS, Foregut and Bariatric Surgery Fellowship program, Medical Director of the Weight Management Institute and President-elect of the medical staff.

Alongside his clinical commitments, Dr. Dan is deeply engaged in academic pursuits, considered for promotion to Professor of Surgery at NEOMED in 2024.
