ASMBS Integrated Health (IH) President Lisa West-Smith, PhD, LISW-S is the first behavioral health member to serve in this leadership role. Dr. West-Smith is an Associate Professor in the Department of Psychiatry & Behavioral Neuroscience and Department of Surgery at the University of Cincinnati College of Medicine. She also serves as Director of Behavioral Health Services at the UC Health Weight Loss Center. In over two decades of practice in the behavioral treatment of obesity, Dr. West-Smith has conducted over eight thousand pre-surgical psychosocial assessments for individuals pursuing surgical treatment; during that time she has also provided behavioral health services for post-surgical and medical weight loss patients.

Physicians/Surgeons
